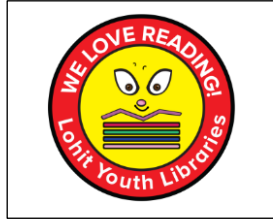

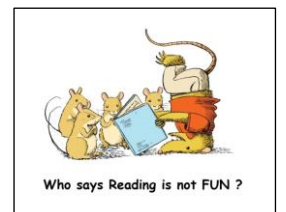

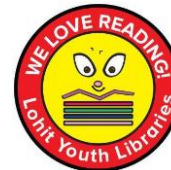

Esteemed Patrons, well-wishers, friends and book-lovers,

It is with mixed feelings that we present you the 18th Annual Report of the youth library movement. We indeed feel deeply elated that this year too was a time of fulfilment for the volunteers at HQ., Bamboosa Library Tezu and our mentors.

Yet we also experienced a great loss to the movement due to the passing away of two very dear and esteemed patrons: Capt. (retd) KK Venkatraman, (May 27, 2024), our founder patron at Chennai, who devoted the last 43 years for the educational progress of Arunachali youth till his last day; & Sri. U. V Eradi, IRS (retd), Kozhikode, (Feb 22, 2025) an eminent cultural leader and a devoted well-wisher of Arunachali children since 1997. We also mourn the demise of our dear patron Smt. Leela Varma, IAAS, Mumbai, an avid book lover (Dec 8, 2024) and renowned writer of Amar Chitra Katha comics Smt. Kamla Chandrakant, (Feb 9, 2025), who too was an early patron of our movement. The Library volunteers and mentors record our profound condolences to the bereaved family members and offer our salutations to these noble souls.

We dedicate this Annual Report to late Capt. Venkatraman ji (fondly known across Arunachal as Capt. ji)....

Here are some of the memorable events for the library movement during the year 2024-25:

For a second year, the Library Network had the honour of being invited to the prestigious Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, (LBSNAA) Mussoorie, when our senior volunteer Ms. Keselo Tayang addressed the senior officers from NE India on taking reading movement to rural areas, with the Coordinator joining the session online. <https://tinyurl.com/57w9fh5h>

The Coordinator was invited to prestigious institutions like IIT Gandhinagar, IIT Bombay, Malabar Christian College, Kozhikode, while the senior and Jr. volunteers participated in many conferences outside the Lohit-Dibang region, all of which brought out the impact of the library movement and the role of reading on the educational empowerment of Arunachal youth.

For a second year, our volunteer Ms Behelti Ama, student, Kalakshetra, Chennai, presented her paintings in a wildlife Art exhibition by MoEF, GOI at Delhi in Oct 2024, winning appreciation from VIPs like the External Affairs Minister of Govt of India, Dr S. Jaishankar. <https://tinyurl.com/mr49k9tm> In Nov 2024, Ms Ashapmai Dellang, of Wakro Sisters also attended a Carnatic music symphony by MoC, GOI at New Delhi.

May 2024 saw the first ever Carnatic music recital in Arunachal by Wakro Sisters, actively supported by 2 youth volunteers from Kerala – Devnarayan (violin) & Sreehari Bhattathiripad (Mridangam). The team received warm appreciations at the public recitals in the RGU University and the RK Mission Hospital auditorium, Itanagar & the Dibrugarh University. The duo, having now completed their UG course in the Kalakshetra Foundation, will be joining for MA studies.

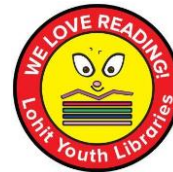
Increase in the number of reader-visitors to the HQ Bamboosa Library: You will be pleased to learn that the increase in the number of reader-visitors to the HQ Bamboosa Library continued. The average monthly footfall this year rose to 614 visitors, as compared to 521 during the previous year 2023-24. It reinforces our conviction that readers get attracted to a library when it presents a range of activities to strengthen their reading habits.

The year also saw a happy development of senior defence officers attending different events at Bamboosa Library HQ, and emerge as leading patrons of the youth Library movement. This was mainly due to the immense goodwill created for the movement, by our late patron Capt. KK Venkatraman, an outstanding former officer of the 6 Kumaon. We are deeply grateful to all of them, esp., 6 Kumaon, 4 Madras, 1900 Field Regt & the IAF HQ.

It was also a year, when the Library Movement received handsome gifts from patrons in the form of books as well as 2 desktop computer-sets for Bamboosa Library, adding a great impetus to our work. Our volunteers could also do many radio programmes at Akashvani (AIR), Tezu and Itanagar.

Quiz programmes for Tezu students: The Bamboosa Library broke fresh grounds by holding Quiz programmes for Tezu school students of all classes from class 3 to 12, two quiz sessions for college students, as also 2 Quiz on Akashvani (AIR) Tezu. A wide range of topics were covered in these quizzes, to help them improve their general awareness and thus improve their learning curiosity and academic performance. to help them improve their general awareness and thus improve their learning curiosity and academic performance. Over 200 students participated in these quiz programmes.

From 2025, Bamboosa Library has again started a monthly written open Quiz series for students of classes 8 -12.

Kaman & Tawra Mishmi language workshops: The Bamboosa Library also made an impressive contribution by holding Kaman & Tawra Mishmi language workshops to sensitise the local people about promoting written literary forms in Arunachal languages. This could be done, thanks to the enthusiastic efforts of our senior volunteers, who also attended some important language development conferences, as well as the support of some eminent linguists, who visited Bamboosa Library.

The movement also received a major setback, when 2 of our active youth libraries Dibang Youth Library, Roing and the APNE Library Wakro, as well as the dormant Lathao Youth Library in Namsai District, had to stop functioning almost throughout the year, due to being forced to shift to new premises. We are making efforts to re-start these 3 libraries in new premises during the coming FY 2025-26. We appeal to all our gracious patrons to extend your support to meet the unexpected additional financial burden that has emerged for these libraries.

We record our profound gratitude to all Govt agencies, state leaders, NGOs, patrons, guests, media, parents of our readers and volunteers as well as our donors for supporting the youth library movement whole-heartedly. We look forward to your continued patronage in the coming year also.

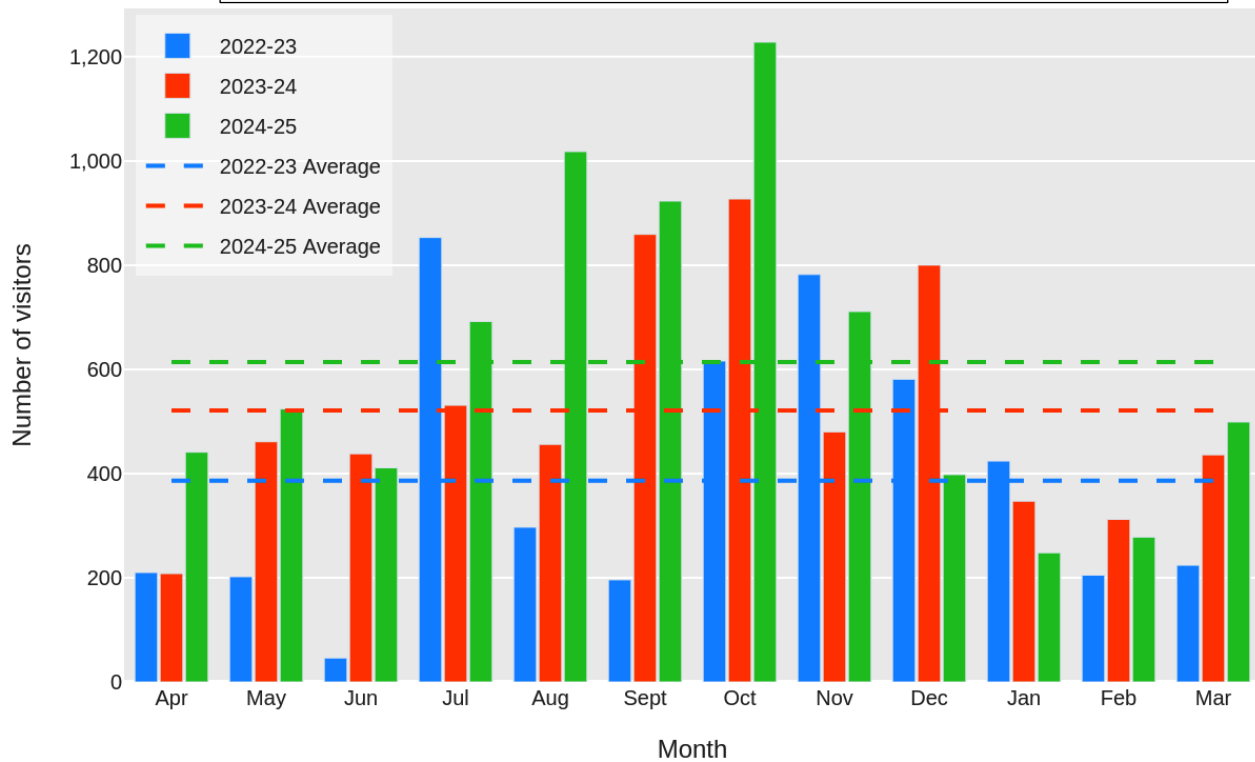

Reading Promotion Activities in & by Libraries & 2024 -25

Bamboosa Library, Tezu: open daily throughout the year. Very happy to report that the average monthly footfall in 2024-25 increased to 614 visitors, (as compared to 521 in 2023-24). It served a large number of primary school students with creative activities during the annual Apr -May school vacation. After schools reopened, several new events were held during 2024-25, apart from reading training sessions for senior students of schools & college.

APNE Library Wakro & Medo Youth Library too organised activities periodically till Dec 2024. Both Wakro & Roing libraries are temporarily closed for being shifted to more suitable & convenient premises.

April 13, 2024: Bamboosa Library Tezu held a presentation by writer-artist Wanggo Socia on “How stories are made”. Audience of college and school students found the session highly interesting.

Apr 22, 2024: Earth Day workshop conducted at Bamboosa Library by AMYAA NGO, Roing. Artist Sri Niranjana Nayak of AMYAA guided the readers to prepare many artistic pieces from mud and natural resources.

Apr 23, 2024: World Book Day celebrated at Bamboosa Library: A special attraction was a display of colour Postcards depicting Constitution Mothers, brought out by PMG Bangalore (gifted by Smt Geetanjali Dhar, Bangalore)

May 10, 2024: APNE library, Wakro organised a Reading Campaign event with junior volunteers of Bamboosa Library doing activities. APNE Library has functioned all May, thanks to the initiative by Forum of Library Activists.

May 23, 2024 : Sri PMS Nambudiri, a 91 year old former DTO, BSNL Tezu, & a 1962 War hero visits Tezu: Sri Nambudiri, serving as Wireless Operator I/c at Ziro in the then NEFA had received a GOI' Commendation Certificate for his meritorious services during war time. He narrated his experiences at Ziro during 1962 War. His son Sri. Krishnan & daughter Ms Shobha, former students of Tezu schools also narrated their fond memories of Tezu days.

May 27, 2024: Arunachal VKVans' "Captji" is no more... Capt (retd) KK Venkatraman, (fondly called Capt ji,) one of the leading founder-patrons of the Library Movement and a highly respected pioneer of the VKV schools in Arunachal, who served Arunachal youth from 1980s till his last day, passed away suddenly at Chennai on May 27th. A brilliant officer of 6 Kumaon Regt., he was mourned by a large circle of senior army officers, friends, admirers and his former students.
