



- \* After school sessions from 4 to 5.30 pm
- \* Batches of 25 interested school students
- \* Uses only joyful and fun language activities like story-telling, poem recitation, skits & language games, using library books.
- \* Students get ample chances to perform themselves
- \* Students freely go through library books.




